The Sports Knee and Shoulder COE meeting scheduled for 25–26 March 2021 is aimed at the generalist but will also be of interest to the sub-specialist. The theme is 'Keeping It Simple' and the aim is to provide clinicians with the key factors in making management decisions for commonly encountered clinical scenarios.

The COE meeting will be entirely case-based with expert panels discussing a variety of cases to highlight key points in the decision making process.

At the conclusion of each topic there will be some summary slides, but the value will really be in hearing how experienced surgeons think.

Given the uncertainties surrounding COVID, the meeting will be a hybrid meeting. This will allow for both in-person attendance in Sydney as well as online attendance from any location. As far as possible, the panel members will be present in person. We are trying to make the online experience as close to an in-person experience as possible.



The meeting will run over two days with alternating knee and shoulder sessions. For the knee, the key topics will be patellofemoral instability, ACL tears, meniscal tears, PCL, MCL and osteochondritis dissecans. For the shoulder the key topics will be anterior and posterior instability, rotator cuff tears and acromioclavicular joint problems.

We encourage you to join us for what we hope will be an interesting and informative meeting.
